



What is *Paint Jamestown*?

•*Paint Jamestown* provides Jamestown residents with a selection of historic color schemes to use for painting the outside of their properties. In addition, starting in 2019, there were grants awarded for homeowners that use these historic colors and live **within Allen Park/UPMC Chautauqua Jamestown Renaissance Block Challenge target area**. Homeowners in that target area can fill out a simple application, and if the project is approved and completed by October 30th, 2023, will receive up to a 25% reimbursement on their painting project, not to exceed \$2,500. Awardees will have a photo of their home featured on Jamestown Renaissance website and facebook page. Funds are limited and subject to first come, first served.

Who is eligible?

1. Property owners living anywhere within the Jamestown city limits **may use the historic color schemes as a reference to paint their homes.**
2. **Property owners with property within the Allen Park/UPMC Chautauqua Jamestown Renaissance Block Challenge target area may apply for the funding grant.**
3. One property per application.

How do I apply?

4. Fill out and turn in this application (see the back of this flier).
5. **If your application is approved**, paint the outside of your property using one of the 50 historic color schemes provided in the *Paint Jamestown* historic color booklet. This booklet can be found at: <http://jamestownrenaissance.org/neighborhoods/>. The entire house must be painted using the selected scheme and multiple colors.
6. Only the colors within a single scheme can be used. Property owners are free to rearrange the recommended placements (body, trim, accent) in any manner they choose.
7. Send in to the Jamestown Renaissance Corporation:
 - A before and after-the-project-is-finished digital photograph of the property.
 - Photocopies of all receipts for paint, supplies or contracted labor.
 - Work done by the owners (sweat equity) is not reimbursable.
8. After processing incoming materials, a reimbursement check for up to 25% of the cost of your painting project will be issued (up to \$2,500).

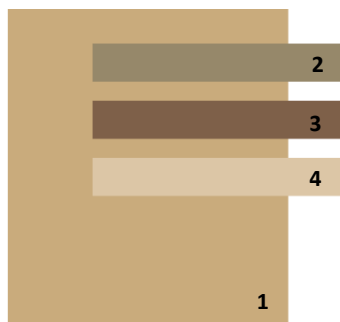
